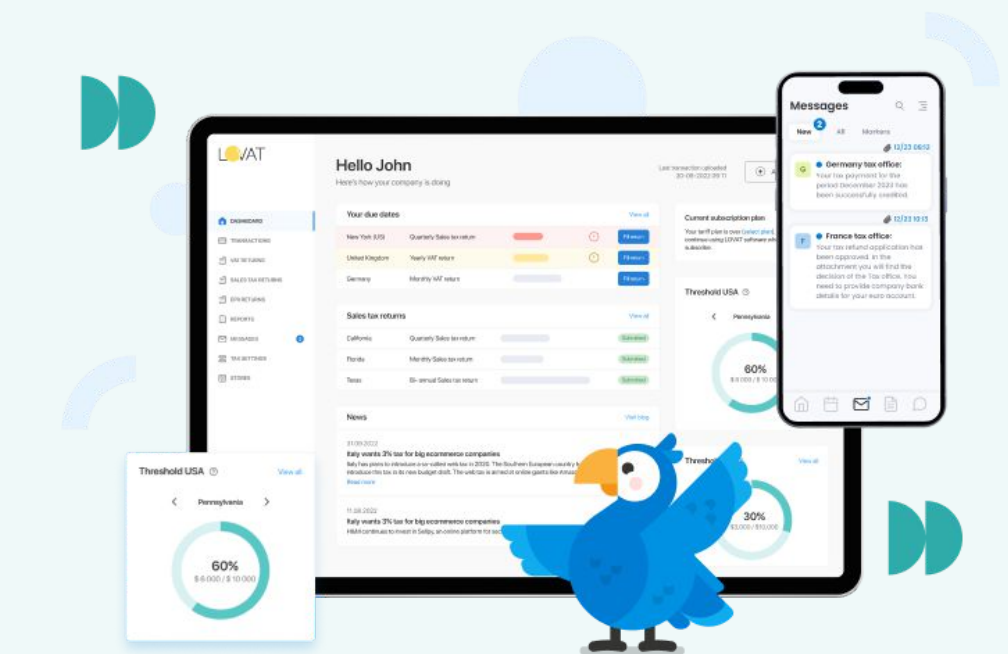

What is EPR?

Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) is a new type of environmental policy that places responsibility on the shoulders of the manufacturer to manage the waste caused by the different types of products they market in order to reduce their environmental impact.

EPR Report

In most countries and categories, reporting is annual. However, quarterly reporting is becoming more and more popular, which initially concerned large companies, and now this trend has spread to small sellers. Reporting deadlines are set by the licensees, so they depend on your license agreement, usually from 1 January to 1 August, depending on the country.

You can easily submit reports for all your countries and categories on the Lovat platform. Additionally, Lovat users don't need to worry about missing this deadline because they can always check their EPR deadline on their Lovat dashboard. You will also receive reminders about EPR deadlines and never miss your EPR deadline.

What are EPR product categories?

Today, the scope of application extends to such categories as:

- ✓ Packaging
- ✓ Textiles
- ✓ Furniture
- ✓ Toys
- ✓ Sports and outdoor activities
- ✓ Batteries
- ✓ Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE)

* In certain countries, like France, the EPR category list is much broader

Authorized Representative for non-resident

Non-resident companies, in most cases, must appoint an Authorized Representative who will be jointly and severally responsible for compliance with the EPR rules for each of the required categories. The representative must be a company with a registered address and the right to act as a representative for other companies. Lovat's services include the following.

Packaging labeling

Proper sorting of packaging waste at home is crucial for recycling. End users are often unsure which container to put each package or part in. As a result, the regulatory authorities in each country have introduced approved rules that clearly explain where and what information should be indicated on the packaging itself to help consumers sort waste correctly in the future. Examples of such rules include the Triman logo in France, the Green Dot in Germany, the Labelling Requirements in Spain, and others.

EPR fees

190 EUR	to register a company for the packaging category
250 EUR	to register a company for other categories
190 EUR	EPR Subscription (include one packaging report)
150 EUR	addon for packaging report (one additional report)
250 EUR	addon for other category report (one additional report)

Time Frame

Registration times vary by region, category, and country. It typically takes between 2 weeks and 3 months, assuming all necessary documents are provided. More detailed information on each region can be found on our [website](#).
